

## **Relevant Information of VISA ON ARRIVAL for Chinese, Hong Kong and Macau Ordinary Passport holders**

- Chinese, Hong Kong and Macau Ordinary Passport holders will be allowed the Tourist Visa On Arrival at the International Airports of Yangon, Mandalay and Nay Pyi Taw in Myanmar starting from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2018.
- Visa on Arrival Fee is US\$ 50 and duration of stay will be allowed (30) days.
- Applicant must fill the necessary facts with English and Chinese Language in the application form that will distribute in the flight.
- As it is only for the visit, there will be allowed only tourist visa and cannot extend the stay in Myanmar.
- Package Tour and FIT (Free Independent Traveler) will be allowed with the Visa on Arrival.
- Although visitors do not need to submit any recommendation documents of the department, organization and tour agency, visitors must be accountability for their visit tours.
- Visitors who are holding ordinary passports from China, Hong Kong and Macau entered visa on arrival -
  - Have to abide by the existing laws and procedures of Myanmar.
  - Apart from the restricted areas according to the security, the visitors can travel the places where the foreigners are permitted.
  - When the visitors arrives the International airport, they need to show US\$ 1000 as the show money.
  - Correspondence Security, organization and immigration department will check the visitors who will enter with visa on arrival. If they could not allow to entry for visitor, they will be rejected.
  - Need to show the return air ticket within one month (or) air ticket for continue to depart to other country.
  - Visitors who entered from the International Airport can leave any International airports.
